## STYLE BULLETIN

### No. 12

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## Instructions *for* HAT ON COVER

### LADY'S CROCHETED HAT

Minerva Silk Mix. 2 Balls No. 77, 1 Ball No. 59.  
1 M. M. No. 3 Crochet Hook.

CROWN—With No. 77 ch. 3, join in a ring, work 8 s.c. in ring. Row 2—1 s.c. in first set, \* 2 s.c. in next st, 1 s.c. in next st., repeat from \* around. Row 3—\* 1 s.c. in each of 2 sts., 2 s.c. in next st., repeat from \* around. Row 4—\* 1 s.c. in each of 3 sts., 2 s.c. in next st., repeat from \* around. Continue increasing at the 8 increasing points, always having 1 more s.c. in each section until there are 100 s.c. around, then work without increasing until crown measures 5 inches from start. Now work the block pattern, \* 5 s.c. of No. 77, 5 s.c. of No. 59, repeat from \* around, work 5 rows, then reverse the blocks so No. 59 comes under No. 77, then with No. 77 work 1 row, on next row increase 1 st. in every 5th st., work 5 rows with No. 77, then 1 row of blocks, 3 rows of No. 77, working last row over a 35-inch hat wire.

Take a piece of cardboard 6 inches long and wrap No. 59 over same 50 times, tie at one end and cut other end to form a tassel. With No. 77 ch. 3, join in a ring, work 7 s.c. in ring, next row work 2 s.c. in each st., now work without increasing for 4 rows, slip over top of tassel and sew to hat as illustrated.







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**MINERVA****M****YARNS**

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**A****LADY'S CROCHETED HAT**

Minerva Thistledown, 2 Balls Buff, 1 Ball Seal Brown. 1 M. M. No. 3 Crochet Hook.

**CROWN**—With buff ch. 3, join in a ring, work 7 s.c. in ring. Row 2—2 s.c. in each st. Row 3—1 s.c. in first st., \* 2 s.c. in next st., 1 s.c. in next st, repeat from \* around. Row 4—1 s.c. in first 2 sts., \* 2 s.c. in next st., 1 s.c. in each of next 2 sts., repeat from \* around. Continue increasing by working 2 s.c. in each of the 7 widening points and always having 1 more s.c. between each widening point, until there are 100 s.c. around. Then work without increasing until crown measures 7 inches from start.

**BRIM**—Turn work and increase 1 st. every 5th st., now work 9 rows buff, 2 brown, 2 buff, 4 brown, 2 buff, 2 brown, 4 buff, working last row over a 28-inch hat wire.

**MOTIVE**—With brown ch. 15 join in a ring, work 30 d.c. in ring, join, break off yarn. Ch. 2, work 6 s.c. in first st., now work 2 s.c. in each st. until there are 16 s.c. around, work 3 rows plain, then decrease 1 st. every 3rd st., until all are taken off, ch. 12. Work another ball to correspond. Sew to hat as illustrated. Brush the entire hat with wire brush.

**B****LADY'S CROCHETED HAT**

Minerva Knitting Worsted, Germantown 4 Fold or Silk Mix, 3 Balls Color. 1 M. M. No. 3½. Crochet Hook

**CROWN**—The crown is made in 4 sections. Ch. 3, work in plain afghan st., increasing 1 st. at each end every row until there are 30 sts. across, then work 15 rows without increasing, work a row of s.c. on both shaped sides of piece just made (not across the bottom), work the 4 sections, then join them together with a row of s.c., taking up the back loop only to form a heavy rib.

**BRIM**—Work 140 s.c. around crown, now work in s.c. until brim measures 3 inches, working the last row over a 35-inch hat wire. Turn the brim down on the side and finish with 2 small pom-poms.







## C

### LADY'S BRUSHED WOOL HAT

Minerva Thistledown, 2 Balls White, 1 Ball Black.  
1 M. M. No. 3 Crochet Hook.

With black ch. 3, join in a ring, work 7 s.c. in ring, on the next 2 rows work 2 s.c. in each st., now increase enough to keep work flat until crown measures 14 inches in diameter, working 5 inches black, 3 inches white,  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch black,  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch white, now with white, decrease on next 2 rows until 22 inches remain, work 1 inch for band, on next row increase by working 2 s.c. in every 4th st., then work without increasing 2 inches white,  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch black,  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch white, working the last row over a 35-inch hat wire.

CORD—With white yarn double crochet a cord 36 inches long, draw through band at intervals of 2 inches, tie on side with double throw and finish ends with small tassels.

Brush the entire Hat with wire brush.

Note.—Minerva Camel Hair can be used in place of Thistledown, 3 Balls required.

## D

### LADY'S BRUSHED WOOL HAT

Minerva Camel Hair, 2 Balls Natural.  
Minerva Mohair Saxonette, 3 Balls Buff.  
1 M. M. No. 3 Crochet Hook.

CROWN—With Mohair Saxonette double work up the 3 balls into a ch.; this ch. is used as a foundation. With Camel Hair work 7 s.c. in first st. of ch., next row work 2 s.c. in each st. (the entire hat is worked over the ch., care being taken not to draw the ch. tight), next row 2 s.c. in every other row, now increase enough to keep work flat until crown measures  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches in diameter and 24 inches on outer edge. Now work without increasing until crown measures 7 inches from centre or 8 inches if a deeper crown is desired. On next row increase for the brim by working 2 s.c. in every 5th st., work  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches for brim, working last row over a 28-inch hat wire. Brush the entire hat with wire brush.

### GIRL'S BRUSHED WOOL TAM

Minerva Mohair Saxonette 2 Balls Color.

1 M. M. No. 3 Crochet Hook.

Chain 3, join in a ring, work 7 s.c. in ring. Row 2—Work 2 s.c. in each st. Row 3—2 s.c. in each st. Now work one row plain after each increasing row. Row 5—\* 1 s.c. in each 2 sts., 2 s.c. in next st., repeat from \*. Row 7—\* 1 s.c. in each of 3 sts., 2 s.c. in next st., repeat from \*. Row 9—\* 1 s.c. in each 4 sts., 2 s.c. in next st., repeat from \*. Row 11—\* 1 s.c. in each 5 sts., 2 s.c. in next st., repeat from \*. Now increase on every other row, working 2 s.c. in every 8th st. until work measures 35 inches around the edge, then work without increasing until crown measures 14 inches in diameter, now decrease every 10th st., working 1 row plain after each decreasing row until desired head size is obtained (22 inches). Work 8 rows, then turn back 4 rows on wrong side and sew in place.

Brush the entire Tam with Wire Brush.

Note.—Minerva Camel Hair can be used in place of Mohair Saxonette. 2 balls are required.

## F

### CHILD'S BRUSHED WOOL HAT

Minerva Mohair Saxonette, 2 Balls Color.

1 M. M. No. 4 Crochet Hook.

3-year size.

Ch. 4, join in a ring, work 8 s.c. in ring, next row work 2 s.c. in each st., now increase enough to keep work flat until crown measures 22 inches on outer edge, now work without increasing until crown measures 7 inches from start, on next row decrease 8 sts. at equal intervals, turn work and work 7 rows of s.c. for turn back, finish with a row of slip sts. Brush the entire hat with wire brush and trim with crocheted flowers.

**FLOWERS**—Are made of contrasting colors of Minerva Silk Mix. Ch. 3, join in a ring, \* 1 s.c. in ring, ch. 3, repeat from \* until there are 5 loops of 3 ch. sts. around. Now work the petals as follows: \* 1 s.c. on first loop, then 1 slip d.c., 3 d.c., 1 slip d.c., 1 s.c., all worked over loop, repeat from \* on all 5 loops. Work 5 flowers; the stem is worked in the ch. st. Leaves—Ch. 9, work 1 s.c., 1 slip d.c., 4 d.c., 1 slip d.c., 1 s.c. all on ch., work 4 leaves and sew to hat as illustrated.

## G

### CHILD'S BRUSHED WOOL HAT

Minerva Camel Hair, 1 Ball Natural.

Minerva Thistledown, 1 Ball Seal Brown.

1 M. M. No. 3 Hook.

1 Pr. M. M. No. 3 Needles.

With Camel Hair ch. 4, join in a ring, work 7 s.c., in ring, next row work 2 s.c. in each st. now increase enough to keep work flat until crown measures 4 inches in diameter then increase every 10th st., until work measures 9 inches, now work without increasing until work measures 10½ inches, now decrease 1 st. every 10th st. until desired head size is obtained (18 inches), work 1½ inches for band. Now measure 8 inches for front. on remaining 10 inches work 2 rows of s.c. with brown yarn.

**BAND FOR FRONT**—With brown cast on 2 sts., k. plain, increasing 1 st. at each end every other row until there are 12 sts. on needle. k. 5 ribs, then k. 2, p. 2, for 4 rows, next row k. 2 together 6 times, 6 sts. on needle, k. 1 row plain, next row increase to 12 sts. again, k. until band measures 7½ inches, finish second end same as first.

Sew band to hat, and brush the entire hat with wire brush.

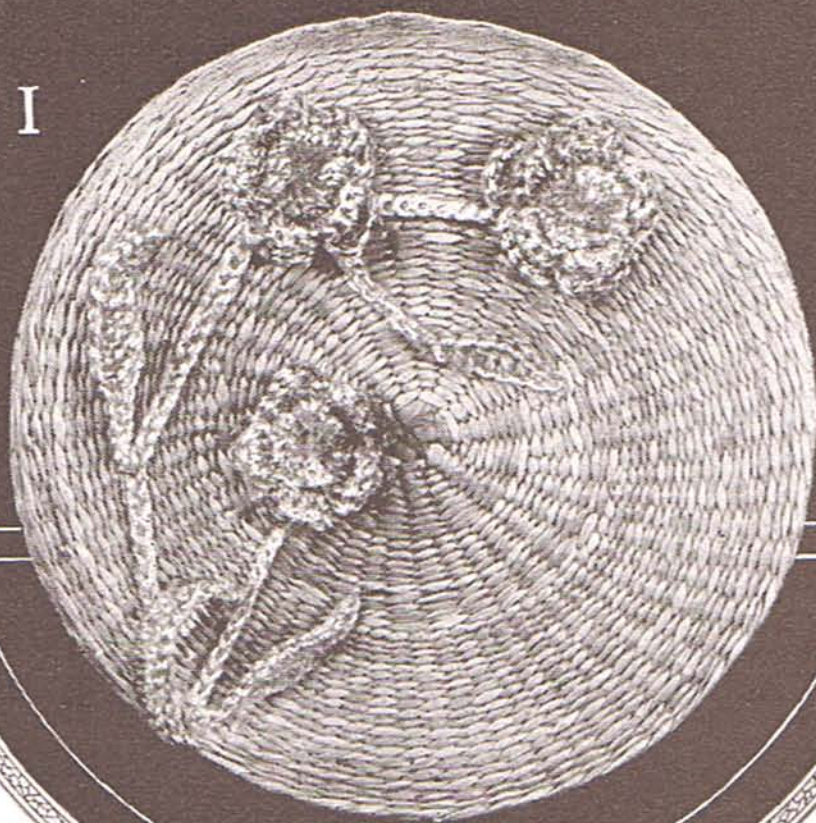

### DAISIES (*On Basket*)

3 shades of yellow Minerva Germantown Zephyr,  
4 fold and 1 shade of green, 1 white.  
1 M. M. No. 2 Crochet Hook.

FLOWER—With white ch. 2, work 6 s.c. in first st. of ch. Row 1—2 s.c. in each st. Row 2—Increase by working 2 s.c. in every other st., break off yarn. Now take a thread of yellow about 2½ yards long and thread in a darning needle, join yarn in first s.c. in circle just made, hold circle between thumb and 3rd finger, \* wind yarn over index finger, draw through s.c., repeat from \* around, working 2 loops in each s.c.

LEAVES—See instructions No. 9. For stems take a piece of wire the desired length and with green yarn wrap over wire wrapping over the ends of leaves, when desired, to join leaves to stem.

## I

### SPRING FLOWERS (*On Basket*)

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 573-533-943-833-923-543-563. 1 M. M. No. 2 Hook.

Work 1 or more flowers up of each shade.

FLOWERS—Ch. 4, join in a ring, \* 1 s.c. in ring, ch. 3, repeat from \* until there are 5 loops. then work \* 1 s.c., 1 sl. d.c., 3 d.c., 1 sl. d.c., 1 s.c. on loop, repeat from \* on all loops. The centre is worked in french knots of black yarn.

LEAVES—Ch. 13, work 2 s.c., 8 d.c., 2 s.c. on ch., if a larger or smaller leaf is desired make ch. accordingly. All stems are made of double yarn.









## J

### MORNING GLORIES

1 Ball each Minerva Lustre Wool 703-723-503-823-533-563-153. 1 M. M. No. 2 Hook.

Work 1 or more flowers of each shade.

FLOWER—Ch. 3, join in a ring, work 5 s.c. in ring, then work 2 s.c. in each st. (10 s.c. around), work 3 rows plain, now work a row of t.c., working 3 t.c. in each s.c. (30 t.c.), next row work in s.c., working 2 s.c. in every 3rd st. Now wrap black yarn over 2 fingers 30 times, tie firmly at one end and draw down through centre of flower, cut other end even with flower. For leaves see instruction I. All stems are worked with yarn double.

## K

### FORGET-ME-NOT

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 503-823-723-573-733. 1 M. M. No. 2 Hook.

Work 3 or more flowers of each shade. Ch. 3, join in a ring, \* work 1 s.c. in ring, ch. 5, repeat from \* around, having 5 petals, each petal being formed by the ch. 5, next row work a petal between each petal of preceding row. When all flowers are finished bunch together and tie in a knot close to flowers and allow 4 inches of each color yarn to extend beyond knot

## L

### BACHELOR BUTTONS

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 503-703-823-543-573-943. 1 M. M. No. 3 Hook.

Work 2 or more flowers of each color. Ch. 3, join in a ring, work 5 s.c. in ring, next row work 2 s.c. in each st., now work 4 rows plain. Wrap the same color of yarn that flower is made of over 2 fingers 40 times, tie firmly at one end, draw down through centre of flower and cut ends even with flowers.

Tie flowers together and leave ends of yarn about 4 inches long.

## M

### BLACK-EYED SUSANNE

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 573-813-153. 1 M. M. No. 2 Hook.

Use No. 573 for flowers, 813 for centre, 153 for leaves and stems.

FLOWER—Ch. 4, join in a ring, \* work 1 s.c. in ring, ch. 8, work 7 slip d.c. on ch., now slip st. in the s.c. at base of petal, ch. 8, work 7 slip d.c. on ch., and repeat from \* until there are 8 petals around. Now work a petal between each petal of preceding row.



## M

(Continued)

For the centre, wrap the yarn over two fingers 50 times, tie firmly at one end, cut other end and trim down to a flat pompom, sew to centre of flower.

LEAVES—Ch. 13. Work 2 s.c., 8 d.c., 2 s.c. on ch., ch. from 3 to 5 sts. for stems. All stems are made of yarn double and ch. st.

## N

### THISTLE

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 823-883.

1 M. M. No. 3 Hook.

FLOWER—Wrap 823 over a 3-inch cardboard 90 times, tie firmly at one end, and cut the other end same as for tassel, now with wire brush, brush flower well so same is soft and fluffy. With 883, ch. 3, join in a ring, work 6 s.c. in ring, next row work 2 s.c. in each st., then work 4 rows plain, draw flower down through centre, and cut ends so 1½ inches show above the green.

LEAVES—Join green yarn at the base, ch. 6, work 5 s.c. on ch., work 2 more leaves, with yarn double work a ch. for stem the desired length.

## O

### DAFFODIL

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 963-153.

FLOWER—The bell part is worked first, ch. 3, join in a ring, work 5 s.c. in ring, next row work 2 s.c. in each st, next row work 2 s.c. in every other st., work 3 rows plain. Join yarn at base of bell, ch. 9, work 1 s.c., 6 d.c., 1 s.c., on ch., work 4 more petals.

LEAVES—Ch. 21, work 2 s.c., 1 s.d.c., 14 d.c., 1 s.d.c., 2 s.c. For stem work a ch. using 4 strands of yarn.

## P

### WATER LILLY

1 Ball each Minerva Embroidery Wool 503-563-813.

FLOWER—With 503 ch. 4, join in a ring, work 6 s.c. in ring, next 2 rows work 2 s.c. in each st., having 24 s.c. around. Now, \* ch. 9 for petal, work 1 s.c., 1 s.d.c., 6 d.c., 1 s.d.c., 1 s.c. on ch., repeat from \* until there are 12 petals. Wrap No. 813 over 2 fingers 50 times, tie firmly at one end and trim down to small pom-pom, sew to centre of flower.

LEAVES—Ch. 14, work 2 s.c., 1 s.d.c., 9 d.c., 5 s.c. in last st., then 9 d.c., 1 s.d.c., 2 s.c. in other side of ch. At the base of leaves ch. 4, and fasten through centre of leaf. For sleeves make a ch. the desired length with yarn double.
